

IN THE MATTER OF THE SEWER IMPROVEMENT
DISTRICT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF
LATERAL SEWERS AS FOLLOWS:

ORDINANCE NO. 1142
for 1964

Beginning at the intersection of Fourth
and Olive Streets and running thence
south along Fourth Street to Harrison
Street; also beginning at the intersection
of Seventh and Harrison Streets and
running thence east to Fifth Street; also
beginning at the intersection of Sixth
and Harrison Streets and running thence
south in Sixth Street one and one-half
blocks, thence east 350 feet, more or
less; also along the alley in Block 1,
Mountain View Addition; also along the
alley in Block 6, Mountain View Addition;
also east along the alley in Boslar
Addition, and thence east 50 feet; also
beginning at the intersection of Fifth and
Olive Streets and running thence north into
Mary Street; also beginning at the west end
of Mary Street and running east along Mary
Street to Third Street. Also beginning at
the intersection of Fifth and Olive Streets
and running thence east along Olive Street to
Third Street; also beginning at the intersection
of Fifth and Olive Streets and running thence
South along Fifth Street to Harrison Street.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TAKING JURISDICTION OF THE PROPOSED SEWER
IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF LATERAL SEWERS, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2 for 1964, passed by the Council
and approved by the Mayor on the 19th day of March, 1964, the Council
declared the area and premises described in the Title to this
Ordinance to be a sewer improvement district; and approved the plans,
specifications and estimates of cost on making said improvements and
caused notice of intention to make said improvements to be given as
provided by the Charter of the City of Lebanon; and,

WHEREAS, the time for remonstrance to be made to said sewer
construction has elapsed, and no remonstrances have been made or
filed herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, DO ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

I.

That the Council does hereby take jurisdiction of said
proposed improvement and orders that the same shall be done by
contract to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder with the
right of the City to reject any, and all bids.

II.

That the Recorder is hereby ordered to publish for ten (10) days in a newspaper published in Lebanon, Oregon, a notice inviting proposals for the making of such sewer improvements referring to the plans and specifications therefore filed in his office, and the time when said work shall be completed.

III.

That said work shall commence not later than ten (10) days after the signing of the contract for said work and shall be completed not later than one hundred twenty (120) days after the date of the signing of said contract.

IV.

That said work shall be done in the manner provided by the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer; and the contractor shall be subject to the penalties for default or failure to complete said work in the manner and within the time provided in his contract with the City, and shall indemnify the City by a bond in an appropriate amount with a surety or sureties approved by the Council for the faithful and prompt performance of said contract, and for the payment of damages for the failure thereof in the sum or sums provided in said contract.

V.

Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
