ORDINANCE NO. 1144

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING RIGHT OF WAY DEEDS FROM KENNETH BUTLER, ET UX; RONALD ELTON WHITMORE, ET UX; FRANK GROVES, ET UX; WESLEY WADE LENOX, ET UX; RALPH M. ZEIGLER, ET UX; EDWARD V. MORAN, ET UX; J. R. ELVIN, ET UX; EDNA ROBBINS; WESTERN OREGON CONFERENCE ASSOCIATION OF SEVENTH DAY ADVENTISTS; PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; AND CROWN ZELLERBACH CORPORATION; CONVEYING AN EASEMENT AND RIGHT OF WAY TO THE CITY OF LEBANON FOR SEWER PURPOSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The People of the City of Lebanon Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the deeds tendered to the City of Lebanon by Kenneth Butler, et ux; Ronald Elton Whitmore, et ux; Frank Groves, et ux; Wesley Wade Lenox, et ux; Ralph M. Zeigler, et ux, Edward V. Moran, et ux; J. R. Elvin, et ux; Edna Robbins; Western Oregon Conference Association of Seventh Day Adventists; Pacific Power & Light Company; and Crown Zellerbach Corporation whereby they have granted to the City of Lebanon the right to use the property described in said deeds for the erection, construction, installation, laying, use, operation, maintenance, repair, and replacement, of a sanitary sewer pipe line, be and the same are hereby accepted, and said right of way and easement is hereby dedicated to the public for the uses therein enumerated.

Section 2. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
