ORDINANCE NO. 1154

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The base salaries of the following city officers and employees, commencing August 1, 1964, and continuing until further Ordinance of the Council, shall be in the amounts set after the office as follows:

City Recorder-Treasurer . . . . .	\$638.00	per month
Assistant City Recorder . . . . .	367.50	"
Police Chief . . . . .	514.25	"
Fire Chief . . . . .	514.25	"
Assistant Fire Chief . . . . .	438.13	"
Public Works (Street) Superintendent . . . . .	559.25	"
City Surveyor . . . . .	3.00	per hour
City Attorney . . . . .	208.33	per month
Municipal Judge . . . . .	150.00	per month

Section 2: All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, which are in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3: The Salaries and Compensation of all other City employees shall be the amount approved by the Budget Committee and adopted in the annual budget. The Base Salaries and Compensation of said employees, effective July 1, 1964, shall be as follows:

Senior Police Sergeant . . . . .	435.50	per month
Junior Police Sergeant . . . . .	425.00	per month

Park Caretaker . . . . .	367.50	per month
Sewage Treatment Plant Operator . . . . .	393.75	per month
Librarian . . . . .	345.83	per month
Assistant Librarian . . . . .	1.25	per hour
Janitor, City Hall . . . . .	172.00	per month
Janitor, Civic Room . . . . .	1.34	per hour
Library Janitor Service . . . . .	30.00	per month
Extra Clerical help . . . . .	1.60	per hour
Extra Library help . . . . .	.75	per hour

Section 4: Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
