THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Contract with MORSE BROS. INC.

for street improvements, and to obligate the City for the payment of \$ 16,465 or for certain street improvements, and that the Contract shall refer to the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Common Council and shall be in the following form, to-wit:
