AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LEBANON,) ORDINANCE NO. 1159
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.)

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1. line 12 of Ordinance No. 1154, which reads as follows: "City Attorney \$208.33 per month" shall be amended to read as follows:

"City Attorney \$300.00 per month"

Section 2. The base salary of the City Attorney as herein provided shall be effective as of July 1, 1964.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
