THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section VII. of Ordinance No. 641 shall be amended by the addition of a subsection (b), which shall read as follows:

"(B) A special permit may be issued by the Police Committee allowing the parking of vehicles operated by physical handicapped people without depositing coins or tokens in a parking meter. The form of application, the cost of such permit, the evidence of the holding of such permit, and the privileges granted shall be established by the Police Committee."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
