THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and instructed to enter into a contract with \_\_\_\_\_

for the construction of lateral sewers, to-wit: Beginning at the manhole at the north end of Grove Street and running thence south approximately 270 feet; also beginning at Seventh Street and running thence west in the alley of Block 2, Mountain View Addition for a distance of one block, and to obligate the City for the payment of \$4,358.10 for said work and improvements.

Section 2. The contract shall refer to the plans and specifications which were the basis of the bid by the said contractor, and shall require the completion of the work and services according to said plans and specifications.

Section 3. Said contract shall be in the following form, to-wit:

Section 4. Inasmuch as this contract is for the construction and improvement of the City's sewer system it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon that said work be done immediately, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance and contract shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
