A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TAKING JURISDICTION OF THE STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE PAVING OF WEST MAPLE STREET FROM THE END OF THE EXISTING PAVING A DISTANCE WEST OF APPROXIMATELY 180 FEET; FOR THE PAVING OF THIRD STREET FROM MARY STREET NORTH A DISTANCE OF 150 FEET; AND THE PAVING OF SOUTH FIFTH STREET FROM AIRPORT ROAD NORTH TO THE EXISTING PAVING. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE BILL NO. <u>19</u> for 1965 ORDINANCE NO. <u>1184</u>

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has filed plans, specifications and estimates for the street improvement district for the paving of West Maple Street from the end of the existing paving a distance West of approximately 180 feet; for the paving of Third Street from Mary Street North a distance of 150 feet; and the paving of South Fifth Street from Airport Road North to the existing paving, and caused notice of intention to make said improvements to be published in the manner provided by the Charter, and

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WHEREAS, the time for remonstrances to be made to said paving has elapsed and no remonstrances have been made or filed herein; NOW THEREFORE,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

I.

That the Council does hereby take jurisdiction of the street improvement district, to-wit: the paving of West Maple Street from the end of the existing paving a distance West of approximately 180 feet; for the paving of Third Street from Mary Street North a distance of 150 feet; and the paving of South Fifth Street from Airport Road North to the existing paving, and orders that the improvements in said district shall be done by contract to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder with the right to refuse any and all bids.

II.

That the Recorder is hereby ordered to publish for ten days

Ordinance No. _____ Page 1 in a newspaper published in Lebanon, Oregon, a notice inviting proposals for making the paving improvements in the above named street improvement districts, said notice to be published in such a manner that bids may be received for said districts and referring in said notice to the plans and specifications theretofore filed in the office of the Recorder and the time when said work shall be completed.

III.

That said work in said districts shall commence not later than $\underline{Aug 10, 1965}$ and shall be completed not later than $\underline{SEPT 30, 1965}$.

IV.

That said work in said districts shall be done in the manner provided by the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Council, and the Contractor shall be subject to the penalties for default or failure to complete said work in that manner and within the time provided by his contract with the City, and shall indemnify the City by a bond in an appropriate amount, with a surety or surities approved by the Council for the faithful and prompt performance of said contract and for the payment of damages for the failure thereof in the sum or sums provided in said contract.

v.

Improvement warrants bearing interest at a rate not to exceed 4 percent perannum, evidencing the indebtedness for the construction of the above described improvement are hereby authorized, and said warrants shall constitute a general obligation of the City of Lebanon, and the Mayor and the Recorder are hereby authorized to issue said warrants to pay for said improvements when said payment shall be made callable as funds for the payment thereof shall become available and in any event, not later than two years

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from the date of issuance.

VI.

That existing conditions are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and an emergency is hereby declared and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
