

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE FIXING A
DAY FOR PUBLIC HEARING UPON THE
QUESTION OF DISPENSING WITH AN
ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY FOR
ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.)

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 26
for 1965
ORDINANCE NO. 1191

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the City of Lebanon a written Petition for the annexation of the following described area, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the City Charter of the City of Lebanon does not expressly prohibit the City from dispensing with submitting the question of annexation to the registered voters of the City; and

WHEREAS, ORS 222.120, under such circumstances, permits the City Council to dispense with the election within the City and to declare the territory annexed to the City following a hearing within the City pursuant to law; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1: A public hearing shall be had at 8:00 o'clock P.M. on the 5 day of OCTOBER, 1965, in the Council Chambers at the City Hall in the City of Lebanon, County of Linn, State of Oregon, before the Common Council of said City of Lebanon, at which time and place the registered voters of the City of Lebanon may appear and be heard on the question of said annexation, and whether or not the Common Council shall dispense with submitting the question to the registered voters of the City of Lebanon.

Section 2: The Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby directed to publish a notice of this hearing, once weekly for

Area #1

Beginning at a point on the West boundary line of the City of Lebanon, said point being South 132 feet from the South line of Grant Street; thence West parallel to the South line of Grant Street a distance of 485.3 feet more or less to the Southwest corner of assessor ownership #300 Lebanon Map 10CD; thence North 192 feet to the North line of Grant Street; thence East along the North line of Grant Street to the East line of 8th Street; thence North along the East line of 8th Street to the North line of Sherman Street; thence West along the North line of Sherman Street 234.51 feet; thence North a distance of 320.66 feet more or less to the North line of Ash Street; thence East along the North line of Ash Street to the West boundary line of the City of Lebanon; thence South along said boundary line to the place of beginning.


Area #2

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Vine Street and 10th Street thence West along the South line of Vine Street to the East line of 11th Street; thence South along the East line of 11th Street to the South line of Sherman Street; thence East along the South line of Sherman Street 198.9 feet thence North $0^{\circ}13''$ West 324 feet; thence South $89^{\circ}47\frac{1}{2}'E$ 189.65 feet to the East line of 10th Street; thence North along the East line of 10th Street to the place of beginning.

two successive weeks, prior to the day above set for the hearing, in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Lebanon, and the Recorder shall post notices of the hearing in four public places in the City for a like period of time.


Section 3: Conditions are such that said annexation, if allowed, should be made within the near future, and, it being necessary for the peace, health and general welfare of the residents of the City of Lebanon that said hearing be held as soon as possible, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
