ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY,)
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.) ORDINANCE NO. 1202

WHEREAS, There has been filed with the City of Lebanon a written Petition for the annexation of the following described area, to wit:

Blocks 17 and 18, Hyland Addition to the City of Lebanon,
Linn County, Oregon, and also Block 16, Hyland Addition to the
City of Lebanon, except the South 56 feet of the East 120 feet
thereof, also except the North 124 10/35 feet of the East 120
feet thereof, all in Linn County, Oregon, and except for that part of
of the above described property which now lies within the City
of Lebanon.

Tract 2:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 6 in Block 13, Nichols Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; and running thence South along the West line of Tenth Street 125.71 feet to the North line of Vine Street; thence West along the North line of Vine Street, 64.86 feet; thence North parallel to the West line of Tenth Street, 125.71 feet to the North line of said Lot 6, Block 13, Nichols Addition; thence East along the North line of said Lot 6, a distance of 64.86 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.187 of an acre.

WHEREAS, the City Charter of the City of Lebanon does not expressly prohibit the City from dispensing with submitting the question of annexation to the registered voters of the City; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 222.120, the City Counsel has elected to dispense with submitting the question to the registered voters, and in lieu thereof to declare the territory annexed by ordinance, following the public hearing on the question; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1: A public hearing shall be had at 8:00 o'clock P.M. on
the 15 day of February , 1966, in the Council Chambers at the City
Hall in the City of Lebanon, County of Linn, State of Oregon, before the Common
Council of said City of Lebanon, at which time and place the registered voters
of the City of Lebanon may appear and be heard on the question of said
annexation, and whether or not the Common Council shall dispense with submitting
the question to the registered voters of the City of Lebanon.

Section 2: The Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby directed to publish a notice of this hearing, once weekly for two succesive weeks, prior to the day above set for the hearing, in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Lebanon, and the Recorder shall post notices of the hearing in four public places in the City for a like period of time.

Section 3: Conditions are such that said annexation, if allowed, should be made within the near future, and, it being necessary for the peace, bhealth and general welfare of the residents of the City of Lebanon that said hearing be held as soon as possible, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
