ORDINANCE NO. 1204

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: WHEREAS, at least two-thirds of the landowners of the following described property:

TRACT 1

Blocks 17 and 18, Hyland Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and also Block 16, Hyland Addition to the City of Lebanon, except the South 56 feet of the East 120 feet thereof, also except the North 124 10/35 feet of the East 120 feet thereof, all in Linn County, Oregon, and except for that part of the above described property which now lies within the City of Lebanon.

TRACT 2

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 6 in Block 13, Nichols Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; and running thence South along the West line of Tenth Street 125.71 feet to the North line of Vine Street; thence West along the North line of Vine Street, 64.86 feet; thence North parallel to the West line of Tenth Street, 125.71 feet to the North line of said Lot 6, Block 13, Nichols Addition; thence East along the North line of said Lot 6, a distance of 64.86 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.187 of an acre.

who also own at least two-thirds of the land in the contiguous territory and of real property therein, representing at least two-thirds of the assessed value of all real property in the contiguous territory, have consented in writing to the annexation and filed a statement of their consent with the City Council; and

WHEREAS, said real property is contiguous territory to the City of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, an Ordinance has heretofore been passed declaring that an election within the City of Lebanon shall not be had,
NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 2: Said territory is hereby declared to be annexed to the City of Lebanon, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to make and submit to the Secretary of the State of Oregon a copy

of this Ordinance, together with a copy of the statement of consent of the landowners in said territory, and also a copy of the Ordinance declaring that no election shall be required within the City of Lebanon.

Section 3: Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
