ORDINANCE NO. 1205

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described real property,
situated within the city limits of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon,
be and hereby is changed from "Zone 1" (residential) to "Zone 2"
(residential), to-wit:

The East 324 feet of Lot 28, A. F. BAHRKE'S
FRUITDALE ADDITION to the City of Lebanon,
Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2: That there is a development anticipated in the
above described property at this time which, in the opinion of the
Council, would be advantageous to the City of Lebanon, and inasmuch
as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate
preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the
City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this
Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its
passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

of March, 1966.
