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ORDINANCE NO. 1210

UPON THE WRITTEN CONSENT FILED WITH THE CITY COUNCIL BY LANDOWNERS IN SAID AREA, PURSUANT TO ORS 222.170, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS at least two-thirds of the landowners of the following described property:

who also own at least two-thirds of the land in the contiguous territory and of real property therein, representing at least twothirds of the assessed value of all real property in the contiguous territory, have consented in writing to the annexation and have filed a statement of their consent with the City Council; and

WHEREAS said real property is contiguous territory to the City of ^Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, an Ordinance has heretofore been passed declaring that an election within the City of Lebanon shall not be had, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Said territory is hereby declared to be annexed to the City of Lebanon, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to make and submit to the Secretary of the State of Oregon a copy of this Ordinance, together with a copy of the statement of consent of the landowners in said territory, and also a copy of the Ordinance declaring that no election shall be required within the City of Lebanon.

Beginning at the intersection of the present East boundary of the City of Lebanon with the South line of East Grant Street; and running thence North along said East boundary to a point which is South 15.0 feet from the North line of Lot 24 in Riverdale Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; thence East parallel to the North line of said lot to the East line thereof; thence North along the East line of Riverdale Addition to the Northeast corner of Lot 19 in said addition; thence East 380.0 feet more or less to the East line of the Jeremiah Ralston D.L.C. No. 49 in T. 12 S., R. 2 W. W. M.; thence North along said D. L. C. line to a point which is South 171.4 feet from the Northwest corner of the West projection of the James Hidgeway D. L. C. No. 46 in said township and Range; thence West to the present East boundary of Lebanon; thence North along said East boundary of Lebanon 490.10 feet to a point on an East and West line (which line is North 318.17 feet from the Northwest corner of the West projection of the James Ridgeway D. L. C. No. 46 in said township and range); thence East to a 3/4" Iron pipe on the Westerly right of way line of the Albany-Santiam Canal; thence S. 39° 26' E. along said canal line 223.50 feet to a 3/4" Iron pipe; thence S. 41º 42' E. along said canal line 222.18 feet to a 1/2" Iron pipe; thence S. 70° 28.92' E. along said canal line 115.92 fest to the West line of the West projection of said D. L. C. No. 46; thence North 151.4 feet more or less to the Morthwest corner of the West projection of said D. L. C.; thence East to the Left or Westerly line of the Low Water Elevation of the South Santiam River; thence Southeasterly along said water line of said river up stream to the Northwesterly right of way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad; thence Southwesterly along said railroad line to the South line of Grant Street; thence West Northwesterly along said street line to the place of beginning.

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<u>Section 2</u>. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
