AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1145 CONCERNING DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. ORDINANCE BILL NO. 12 for 1966 ORDINANCE NO. 1212

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1145 shall be amended to read as follows:

> Section 2: "To run at large" shall mean to be off the premises of the owner or person having the control, custody or possession of the dog while said dog is not under the complete control of the owner or such person by adequate leash.

<u>Section 2:</u> Section 3 of said Ordinance No. 1145 shall be amended as follows:

Delete the words "and/or not under the control of their owner or person responsible for the same," as set forth on lines 1 and 2 of said section.

<u>Section 3:</u> Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
