) ORDINANCE NO. 1213

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1. of Ordinance No. 562 is amended by the deletion of the phrase "without the knowledge or consent of the owner or proprietor thereof", and by the addition of the phrase "or agreeing to pay", and shall read as follows:

"Section 1. Within the meaning of this ordinance the term "shoplifting" shall be deemed to mean and include the taking from any shop or store within the limits of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, of any goods, wares, or merchandies, or article thereof, kept or displayed for sale in such shop or store, and without paying, or agreeing to pay, for the same."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
