THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Employees of the City of Lebanon shall receive monthly compensation within the salary range established for their job classification as follows: *amount to amount of present monthly as dictated by the CC.*

Section 2. The Treasurer is authorized and directed to pay each City employee the amount within his job classification salary range as approved by the Council.

Section 3. *Insurances of this Ordinance all other employees except hourly employees city attorney - this and may judge*

Section 3. Ordinance No. 1129, establishing a longevity schedule, is hereby repealed; and the parts of all other Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and superceded by this Ordinance.

Section 4. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
