A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND THE RECORDER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MORSE BROTHERS, INC., an Oregon Corporation, FOR THE PAVING OF FOURTH STREET FROM C STREET TO SHERMAN STREET, AND THE OFF-STREET PARKING FACILITIES AT MAIN AND GRANT STREETS, and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE BILL NO. <u>7</u> for 1966 ORDINANCE NO. <u>1217</u>

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: <u>Section 1.</u> That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Morse Brothers, Inc., an Oregon Corp., for street improvements, to wit: Paving of Fourth Street from C Street to Sherman Street, and the off-street parking facilities located at the Northeast corner of Main and Grant Streets, and to obligate the City of Lebanon for the payment of \$21,561.97 for said street improvements, and that the contract shall refer to the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Common Council, and shall be in the following form, to wit:

<u>Section 2.</u> That inasmuch as this contract is for the improvement of streets, it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon that said work be done immediately, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this contract shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
