THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. SECTION VII of Ordinance No. 641 is amended by deleting subsection (a) thereof, and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

"(a) Business vehicles may park in parking meter zones for not more than 36 minutes while the operator thereof is transacting business in the downtown area of the City of Lebanon, without depositing coins or tokens, provided a fee of \$12.00 per calendar year, payable quarterly, has been paid for such privilege for such vehicle. Payment shall be evidenced by a stamp to be issued by the City and plainly displayed on the vehicle. Parking for a period of time longer than 36 minutes shall be sufficient cause for revoking the privilege granted by such permit, and shall constitute a violation of the Parking Meter Ordinance."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
