ORDINANCE NO. 1236

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No minor under the age of 18 years, unless accompanied by his or her parent or legal guardian, shall be upon a public street or in a public place between the hours of 10:30 P. M. and 5:00 A. M. of the following morning, on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday nights, and between the hours of 12:00 P. M. and 5:00 A. M. of the following morning, on Friday and Saturday nights and any night preceding a legal holiday as defined in O.R.S. 187.010 and 187.020.

Section 2. Violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
