ORDINANCE NO. 1237

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 75 of Ordinance No. 519 is amended by the deletion of the subject matter of said Section and inserting in lieu thereof the following language:

"ESCAPE FROM CUSTODY. It shall be unlawful for any person incarcerated in the city jail or in the custody of a police officer after being placed under arrest to escape or attempt to escape from such custody."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
