ORDINANCE NO. 1239

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section VII of Ordinance No. 837 is amended by the addition of the following language:

Keep
"A Department Head shall have the power, in connection with sidewalk, street or highway repairs or construction, and during emergencies and the obstruction or interference with normal traffic flow, to appoint himself or persons in his department as "special police" for the purpose of directing, regulating or controlling pedestrian and vehicular traffic on the streets, alleys, sidewalks, and all other roads or thorofares within the city; and the failure or refusal of a person to obey the lawful, reasonable signals, directions or orders of such "special police" shall constitute a misdemeanor.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
