ORDINANCE NO. 1346

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person shall drive or move, and no owner shall cause or knowingly permit to be driven or moved, any vehicle in the wrong direction on a street designated by the City as a one-way street, road, or highway. In this Ordinance "wrong direction" shall mean the opposite direction of that designated for the movement of traffic.

Section 2. Violation of this Ordinance shall constitute and be punishable as a misdemeanor.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
