THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon be and they hereby are directed to accept from Edward C. Bilyeu and Inez B. Bilyeu, husband and wife, a deed conveying to the City, free of all reservations, the following described real property located in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 1, Block 3, Edes Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and running thence North 1 foot to a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe; thence west along the south line of Park Drive 50 feet to a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe; thence South 1 foot; thence East parallel to the south line of Park Drive 50 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2. That the Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby directed to file the said deed for record with the County Recorder of Linn County, State of Oregon.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
