ordinance bill no. 2/ For 1967 Ordinance no. 1252

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to store or possess more than six (6) gallons of liquefied gas within the fire limits of the City of Lebanon, and an such gas shall be stored and used only in the manner approved by the requirements and specifications of the Oregon State Fire Marshall.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful to store or possess any larger quantity of liquefied gas than 150 gallons in any place within the City Limits of the City of Lebanon outside the fire limits, and in any case such storage and possession shall be only in containers and under conditions prescribed by the rules and regulations of the Oregon State Fire Marshall.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Countil and approval by the Mayor.
