ORDINANCE NO. 1253

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following Ordinances, concerning the subjects indicated:

- No. 248, relating to gasoline and dry cleaning establishments
- No. 249, relating to public garages and the handling of inflammable material
- No. 250, relating to the storage of explosives
- No. 251, relating to the burning of refuse and disposition of ashes
- No. 362, amending Ordinance No. 248
- No. 432, relating to tank wagons and vehicles transporting flammable liquids

are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
