THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and instructed to enter into a Contract with JAMES G. ROBERTSON, P. O. Box 86, Clackamas, Oregon, for the construction of the West Side Interceptor, Phase 2, in connection with the sewer system, and to obligate the City for the payment of \$164,592.00 for said work amd improvements.

Section 2. That said Contract shall refer to the plans and specifications which were the basis of the bid by the said Contractor and shall require the completion of the work and services in accordance with said plans and specifications.

Section 3. That said Contract shall be in the following form, to-wit:

Section h. Inasmuch as this Contract is for the construction and improvement of Lebanon's sewer system, it is necessary that the work be done without delay and, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance and Contract shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
