ORDINANCE NO. 1280

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person shall take from any shop or store within the limits of the City of Lebanon any goods, wares, or merchandise, or any article thereof, kept or displayed for sale in such shop or store, without paying, or agreeing to pay, for the same.

Section 2. Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 562, enacted May 19, 1942, and Ordinance No. 1213, enacted June 21, 1966, are repealed.

Section 4. Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
