

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
MAYOR AND THE RECORDER TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT WITH GIBSON & GOULD FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF LATERAL SEWERS FROM THE
INTERSECTION OF TENTH AND F STREETS NORTH
A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 420 FEET;
THENCE EAST IN THE CENTER LINE, IF PRODUCED
WEST, OF THE ALLEY IN SUPPLEMENTAL PLAT
OF BLOCKS 33-39 HYLAND ADDITION; THENCE
ACROSS NINTH STREET AND EAST IN THE ALLEY
OF SAID SUPPLEMENTAL PLAT TO A POINT
APPROXIMATELY 540 FEET EAST OF NINTH
STREET, AND TO OBLIGATE THE CITY FOR THE
PAYMENT THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 1297

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and instructed to enter into a Contract with GIBSON & GOULD of Route 2, Box 636, Veneta, Oregon, for the construction of lateral sewers from the intersection of Tenth and F Streets North a distance of approximately 420 feet; thence east in the center line, if produced west, of the alley in Supplemental Plat of Blocks 33-39 Hyland Addition; thence across Ninth Street and east in the alley of said Supplemental Plat to a point approximately 540 feet east of Ninth Street, in connection with the City sewer system, and to obligate the City for the payment of \$9,473.50 for said work and improvements.

Section 2. That said Contract shall refer to the plans and specifications which were the basis of the bid by the said Contractor and shall require the completion of the work and services in accordance with said plans and specifications.

Section 3. That said Contract shall be in the following form, to-wit:

Section 4. Inasmuch as this Contract is for the construction and improvement of Lebanon's sewer system, it is necessary that the work be done without delay and, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance and Contract shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
