ORDINANCE NO. 1304

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 21 of Ordinance No. 1287 is amended to read;

Section 21. Drinking in Public; Drunkenness.

(1) No person shall drink or consume any alcoholic liquor in or upon any street, alley, or publicly owned parking lot.

(2) No person shall be in an intoxicated or drunken condition in or upon any street, alley, publicly owned parking lot, or any other public place, or in a motor vehicle in or upon such place.

Section 2. Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
