A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1288, THE GENERAL OFFENSE ORDINANCE, BY AMENDING AND ADDING PROVISIONS RELATING TO CONCEALED WEAPONS, MOTELS, BUILDING ENTRANCE OBSTRUCTIONS, AND ATTEMPTS TO COMMIT OFFENSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 13 For 1968

ORDINANCE NO. 1305

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. Section 5 of Ordinance No 1288 is amended to read:

Section 5. Concealed Weapons. No person other than an authorized peace officer or person licensed pursuant to ORS 166.290, as now or hereafter amended, shall carry concealed on or about his person or within any vehicle any revolver, pistol, other firearm, knife, other than an ordinary pocketknife with a blade less than three and one-half inches long, dirk, dagger, stiletto, metal knuckles, or weapon the use of which could inflict injury upon a person or property.

Section 2. Section 17 and 18 of Ordinance No. 1288 are amended by adding "motel," after "hotel," throughout these two sections.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 1288 is amended by adding after Section 27 the following:

## MISCELLANEOUS OFFENSES

Section 28. Building Entrances, Obstructing. No person shall obstruct any entrance to any building or loiter unnecessarily about or near any entrance, stairway, or hall leading to any building.

Section 29. Offenses, Attempt to Commit. A person who shall attempt to commit any of the offenses mentioned in this or any other ordinance of the city, but who for any reason is prevented from consummating such act, shall be deemed guilty of an offense.

Section 4. Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
