ORDINANCE NO. 1309

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 909 is amended to read:

" Section 2. PENALTY. Violation of this ordinance shall
constitute a misdemeanor."

Section 2. Subsection (15), (16), and (17) of section 8 of Ordinance
No. 909 are repealed.

Section 3. Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as the provisions of this
ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health
and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
