THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 30 of Ordinance No. 1283 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 30. <u>Reckless Driving</u>. No person shall drive a vehicle upon a street or public property carelessly and heedlessly in a wilful or wanton disregard of the rights or safety of others. A person who violates this Section shall be punished:

- (1) Upon a first conviction, by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than 90 days, or by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both.
- (2) Upon a second or subsequent conviction, by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six months, or by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both."

Section 2. A new Section numbered 30-A shall be added to Ordinance No. 1283, and shall read as follows:

"Section 30-A. Driving While License revoked or suspended. No persons whose operator's or chauffeur's license, or whose right or privilege to operate a motor vehicle, or whose right to apply for a license to operate a motor vehicle in the State of Oregon has been suspended or revoked, under any provision of law, shall drive any motor vehicle in the City of Lebanon during the period stated in the State of Oregon, Department of Motor Vehicles' Order of Suspension or Revocation. A license, permit or registration certificate issued by any other jurisdiction shall not constitute authorization for a person to operate a motor vehicle in the City of Lebanon during the period this Section shall be punished, upon conviction, by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than two days nor more than one year, and there may be imposed in addition thereto a fine of not more than \$1,000.00." <u>Section 3.</u> Section 51 of Ordinance No. 1283 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 51. <u>Penalties.</u> Except for Sections 28 and 30 and 30-A of this Ordinance, violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor."

<u>Section 4.</u> Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
