A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING) ORDINANCE BILL NO. 28 ORDINANCE NO. 1067 RELATING TO) FOR 1968 TRIALS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.) ORDINANCE NO. 1320

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section (1) of Ordinance No. 1067 is amended to read as follows:

"Section (1) Right to Trial by Jury and Deposit for Jury Fee.

Every person charged with any offense defined and made

punishable by the City Charter or any Ordinance of the City

of Lebanon, shall have the right to trial by jury upon giving

notice to the Municipal Judge, in writing, together with a

deposit of \$18.00 jury fee at least five (5) days, excluding

Sundays and legal holidays, prior to the trial date set by

the Municipal Court."

Section 2. Section (11) of Ordinance No. 1067 is amended to read as follows:

"Section (11) Payment of Jurors. Those jurors notified and who appear at trial shall receive compensation from the City of Lebanon in the amount of \$3.00 for each day of attendance upon the Municipal Court."

Section 3. Section (13) of Ordinance No. 1067 is amended to read as follows:

"Section (13) Costs and Disbursements. In all cases and trials held in the Municipal Court of the City of Lebanon, the Court shall, in addition to the penalties prescribed by the Ordinance under which the Defendant has been tried, assess an additional sum against the Defendant as costs. Said costs to be assessed are as follows:

- (a) on a plea of "guilty" \$2.50
- (b) on a plea of "not guilty", either with or without a jury, the Municipal Judge shall add the costs and disbursements to the fine, penalty or sentence imposed, in the sum of not less than \$5.00

Section 4. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
