ORDINANCE NO. 1337

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1283 is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Motor Vehicle Laws of the State of Oregon. The following chapters and sections of Oregon Revised Statutes are incorporated by reference into this ordinance as though fully set forth herein, and any violation or failure to comply with such chapters or sections shall be a violation of this ordinance: Chapter 481, relating to motor vehicle registration and regulation and licensing of dealers and wreckers; Chapter 482, relating to operators' and chauffeurs' licenses; Chapter 483, relating to motor vehicle traffic, equipment, and construction; Chapter 484, relating to traffic safety and traffic offense procedures; Chapter 485, relating to school buses; and sections 164.650, 164.660, 164.670, 166.630, and 649.080.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
