ORDINANCE NO. 1341

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. Section 4. Definitions, Subparagraph (7) of Ordinance No. 1283, which reads as follows:


"(7) Park or parking. The standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when a vehicle is temporarily standing for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading."

is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(7) Park or parking. The standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
