THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of
Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a
contract with Cascade Ditching Service, 4823 Fir Dell Drive,
Salem, Oregon, for sewer improvements, to-wit: The construction
of lateral sewers in Ninth Street from the end of the existing
sewer North a distance of approximately 300 feet and from
thence West through the center of Block 8, Nichols Addition,
a distance of approximately 415 feet, and to obligate the City
of Lebanon for the payment of \$4,694.01 for said sewer improvements,
and that the contract shall refer to the plans and specifications
heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Common
Council, and shall be in the following form, to-wit:

Section 2. That inasmuch as this contract is for the improvement of the city streets, it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon that said work be done immediately, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval of the Mayor.
