BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:


Section 1. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 1254 is amended by the addition of a subparagraph(b) to read as follows:

(b) Article 28, Section 28.1, subparagraph a. is amended to read as follows:


"a. Permit Required. No person shall kindle or maintain any bonfire or rubbish fire or authorize any such fire to be kindled or maintained on or in any public or private street, alley, road or other public or private ground without a permit or other proper authorization. During construction or demolition of buildings or structures no waste materials or rubbish shall be disposed of by burning on the premises or in the immediate vicinity without having obtained a permit or other proper authorization."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
