A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MORSE BROS., SAND & GRAVEL FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 252.37 feet OF SIDEWALK ON THE EAST SIDE OF WILLIAMS STREET BETWEEN DODGE AND WHEELER STREET, and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. ORDINANCE BILL NO. <u>15</u> for 1969 ORDINANCE NO. <u>13</u>50

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: <u>Section 1.</u> That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Morse Bros., Sand & Gravel for the construction of 252.37 feet of Sidewalk on the East side of Williams Street between Dodge and Wheeler Street, and to obligate the City of Lebanon for the payment of \$962.42 for said improvement, and that the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Common Council, and shall be in the following form, to-wit:

Section 2. That inasmuch as this contract is for the improvement of streets, it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon that said work be done immediately, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 7th day of October, 1969.
