) ORDINANCE NO. 1356

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. Sections 4 and 5 of Ordinance No. 1287 (compiled as 5-9.4 and 5-9.5) are amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. Purchase or Possession of Liquor by Minor.

(1) No minor shall purchase or acquire or have in his possession any alcoholic liquor.

(2) The presence of a minor in a vehicle where alcoholic liquor is found shall be prima facie evidence of possession of alcoholic liquor by such minor.

Section 5. Lawful Consumption of Liquor by Minor.


(1) Except when such minor is in a private residence accompanied by his parent or guardian and with such parents' or guardians' consent, no minor shall have in his possession alcoholic liquor.

(2) For purposes of this section, possession of alcoholic liquor includes the acceptance or consumption of a bottle of such liquor or any portion thereof or a drink of such liquor.

(3) When a minor leaves the aforesaid private residence and is not accompanied by his parent or guardian, the aforesaid exception shall not constitute a defense to the charge of minor in possession of alcoholic liquor."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
