ORDINANCE NO. 1357

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. Section 22 of Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.22) is amended to read as follows:


"Section 22. Pedestrians Must Use Crosswalks.  
On Main Street between its intersection with  
Rose Street on the north and Oak Street on the  
south, no pedestrian shall cross other than  
within a marked cross walk."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
