

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION ON JUNE 3, 1970, SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON: (1) A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING A LEVY BY THE CITY OF LEBANON OF A TAX IN THE SUM OF \$196,200.00 OUTSIDE THE CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATIONS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ALL DEPARTMENTS OF THE GENERAL FUND, THE ESTIMATED RATE OF TAX NECESSARY THEREFOR BEING \$4.994 PER \$1,000 OF TRUE CASH VALUE OF ALL THE TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS, BASED ON THE 1969-70 ASSESSED VALUATION; AND (2) A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL LEVY BY THE CITY OF LEBANON OF A TAX IN THE SUM OF \$6,000.00 OUTSIDE THE CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATIONS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE CONTINUANCE OF AMBULANCE SERVICE WITHIN THE CITY OF LEBANON, THE ESTIMATED RATE OF TAX NECESSARY THEREFOR BEING \$0.153 PER \$1,000 OF TRUE CASH VALUE OF ALL THE TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS, BASED ON THE 1969-70 ASSESSED VALUATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a special election be held in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, on the 3rd day of June, 1970, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. and 8:00 o'clock P.M., for the purpose of submitting proposed tax levies in excess of the 6% constitutional limitation which is now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, which have been proposed by the Common Council by Resolution heretofore passed and more specifically set forth as follows:

PROPOSITION (1)

Section (a). That the proposition to be printed on the ballot shall be as follows:

A proposition submitted to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon by its Common Council at a special election to be held on June 3, 1970, for a tax in the sum of \$196,200.00 outside the constitutional 6% limitation, for the fiscal tax year 1970-71 for the purpose of providing funds for the operation and maintenance of all departments of the General Fund, the estimated rate of tax necessary therefor being \$4.994 per \$1,000 of true cash value of all the taxable property within the City Limits, based on the 1969-70 assessed valuation.

Section (b). That the text and ballot title for the proposition shall be as follows:



Shall the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, by and through its Common Council, be authorized to levy a tax in the sum of \$196,200.00 at the estimated rate of \$4.994 per \$1,000 of true cash value against all the taxable property within the City Limits, and outside the constitutional 6% limitation of the State of Oregon, for the fiscal tax year 1970-71, for the purpose of providing funds for the operation and maintenance of all departments of the General Fund.

PROPOSITION (2)

Section (a). That the proposition to be printed on the ballot shall be as follows:

A proposition submitted to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon by its Common Council at a special election to be held on June 3, 1970, for a tax in the sum of \$6,000.00 outside the constitutional 6% limitation, for the fiscal tax year 1970-71, for the purpose of providing funds for the continuance of ambulance service within the City of Lebanon, the estimated rate of tax necessary therefor being \$0.153 per \$1,000 of true cash value of all the taxable property within the City Limits, based on the 1969-70 assessed valuation.

Section (b). That the text and ballot title for the proposition shall be as follows:

Shall the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, by and through its Common Council, be authorized to levy a tax in the sum of \$6,000.00 at the estimated rate of \$0.153 per \$1,000 of true cash value against all the taxable property within the City Limits and outside the constitutional 6% limitation of the State of Oregon, for the fiscal tax year 1970-71 for the continuance of ambulance service within the City of Lebanon.



Section 2. That said proposal for special levies be placed on the official ballot by the City Recorder to be voted on by the legal electors of the City of Lebanon at said election.

Section 3. That the Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby authorized and directed to publish and post notices of said election in the manner provided by law.

Section 4. That the polling places for said election in the City of Lebanon shall be as follows:



Section 6. That the polling places for said election shall be open from the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. to 8:00 o'clock P.M., on said day and that the Chief of Police is instructed to take to the polling places booths, pens, pencils and ballots for the purpose of providing for said election and the Recorder is directed to provide poll books therefor.

Section 7. Inasmuch as the City of Lebanon will be without funds to maintain its services in the coming fiscal year unless the special election herein referred to can be held without delay, the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
