whereas the City Engineer has filed plans, specifications and estimates for the street improvement district for the paving of 6th Street from A Street to D Street; 6th Street from F Street North one-half block to alley; F Street from 6th Street to 7th Street; Sherman Street from 7th Street to 8th Street; 0'Neill Street from Grove Street to east end; Wassom Street from 4th Street to 2nd Street; 3rd Street from Wassom Street to Wendell Street; 2nd Street from Kees Street to Walker Road; Dodge Street from Williams Street to Bromil Street; Mary Street from 3rd Street to west end; and 5th Street from Kees Street to Airport Road, and caused notice of intention to make said paving improvements to be published in the manner provided by the Charter; and

WHEREAS the time for remonstrances to be made to said paving improvements has elapsed and no remonstrances have been made or filed herein, except to Mary Street from 3rd Street to the west end;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Council does hereby take jurisdiction of the street improvement district, to-wit: the paving of 6th Street from A Street to D Street; 6th Street from F Street

North one-half block to alley; F. Street from 6th Street to 7th Street; Mary Street from 3rd Street to West end; Sherman Street from 7th Street to 8th Street; Overill Street from Grove Street to East end; Wassom Street from 4th Street to 2nd Street; Wendell Street from 4th Street to 2nd Street; 3rd Street from Wassom Street to Wendell Street; 2nd Street from Kees Street to Walker Road; Dodge Street from Williams Street to Bromil Street; and 5th Street from Kees Street to Airport Road, and orders that the paving improvements in said district shall be done by contract to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, with the right to refuse any and all bids.

Section 2. That the Recorder is hereby ordered to publish for ten days in a newspaper published in Lebanon, Oregon, a notice inviting proposals for making the paving improvements in the above named street improvement district, said notice to be published in such a manner that bids may be received for said district and referring in said notice to the plans and specifications theretofore filed in the office of the Recorder and the time when said work shall be completed.

Section 4. That said work in said street improvement district shall be done in the manner provided by the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Council, and the Contractor shall be subject to the penalties for default or failure to complete said work in that manner and within the time provided by his contract with the City, and shall indemnify the City by bond in an appropriate amount, with a surety or sutities approved by the Council for the faithfuland prompt performance of said contract and for the payment of damages for the failure thereof in the sum or sums

provided in said contract.

Section 5. Improvement warrants bearing interest at a rate not to exceed \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ percent per annum, evidencing the indebtedness for the construction of the above described street improvements are hereby authorized, and said warrants shall constitute a general obligation of the City of Lebanon, and the Mayor and the Recorder are hereby authorized to issue said warrants to pay for said improvements when said payment shall be made callable as funds for the payment thereof shall become available, and in any event not later than two years from the date of issuance.

Section 6. That existing conditions are such that said street improvements are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
