

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TAKING JURISDICTION
OF THE STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE
PAVING OF 9TH STREET FROM ISABELLA STREET
TO CAROLINA STREET; CAROLINA STREET FROM 9TH
TO 10TH STREET; AND ISABELLA STREET FROM 7TH
STREET TO EAST LINE OF NICHOLS ADDITION,
ACCORDING TO THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS
THEREFOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 1378

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has filed plans, specifications and estimates for the street improvement district for the paving of 9th Street from Isabella Street to Carolina Street; Carolina Street from 9th to 10th Street; and Isabella Street from 7th Street to East line of Nichols Addition, and caused notice of intention to make said paving improvements to be published in the manner provided by Charter; and

WHEREAS, the time for remonstrances to be made to said paving improvements has elapsed and no remonstrances have been made or filed herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Council does hereby take jurisdiction of the street improvement district, to-wit: the paving of 9th Street from Isabella Street to Carolina Street; Carolina Street from 9th to 10th Street; and Isabella Street from 7th Street to East line of Nichols Addition.

Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Article IV, Section 210, Council hereby provides that the work shall be done under the supervision and direction of the City Engineer or other competent person employed by the City.

Section 3. That existing conditions are such that said street improvements are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist,

and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
