A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1288 RELATING TO TRESPASS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. /39/

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. Section 21 of Ordinance No. 1288 (Compiled as 5-10.21) is amended to read as follows:

"Section 21. No person, other than an officer on lawful business, shall go or trespass upon any school grounds, lands or premises not his own, and upon verbal, written or printed notice of the owner or person in lawful occupation of the grounds, lands or premises, shall depart therefrom immediately and remain away until permitted to return."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
