A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 880 RELATING TO CITY PLANNING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ordinance bill no. 34 for 1970 ordinance no. 1393

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 880 (Compiled as 10-3.5) is amended to read as follows:

- "Section 2. (1) The commission shall consist of nine members to be appointed by the mayor, not more than two of whom shall be nonresidents of the city. Commission members shall receive no compensation but shall be reimbursed for duly authorized expenses.
- (2) Not more than two members of the commission may be city officers who, if appointed by the mayor, shall serve as ex officio nonvoting members.
- (3) At the first meeting of the commission, the seven appointed members shall choose their term of office by lot as follows: One for one year, two for two years, two for three years and two for four years. Immediately thereafter, the members shall notify the mayor and council in writing of such allotment. Their successors shall hold office for four years. Any vacancy shall be filled by the mayor for the unexpired portion of the term."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 15th day of December, 1970.
