THE VOTERS A CHARTER AMENDMENT FOR A
\$53,000.00 BOND ISSUE, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 5
for 1971
ORDINANCE NO. 1398

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a special election be held in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, on the 1st day of April, 1971, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City of Lebanon a Charter Amendment for a \$53,000.00 Bond Issue, which has been proposed by the Council by Resolution No. 5 heretofore passed, said proposition being as follows:

Shall the Charter of the City of Lebanon be amended by adding thereto Chapter XVI providing for the issuance of general obligation bonds of the City in the sum of \$53,000.00 to provide funds for bridge construction, participation in Federal Grants for traffic control signals, and park development, City planning, purchase of a street flusher, and construction of a generator storage building; which bonds shall be in such form, be dated and mature as determined by the Council; and authorizing a tax levy to pay the principal and interest on said bonds?

Section 2. That the Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby authorized to publish and post notices of said election in the manner provided by law; and further he shall place said proposal on the official ballot to be voted on by the legal electors at said election.

Section 3. That the polling places for said election in the City of Lebanon

shall be as follows:

Ward One	Precincts 1, 2, 10, 11 City Library Building 626 Second Street Lebanon, Oregon
Ward Two	Precincts 3, 4, & 9 Lebanon Junior High School, South entrance Academy Street Lebanon, Oregon
Ward Three	Precincts 5, 6, 7, & 8 City Hall Council Room 425 Main Street Lebanon, Oregon

Section 4. That the Clerks and Judges of said election shall be as follows:

Ward One	- Judge - Margaret Handt Judge - Irma Marie Weber Clerk - Colleen Cortan Clerk - Ellen Christoph Clerk - Edna Calster
Ward Two	- Judge - Vada Whetstone Judge - Dorothy Fitzgerald Clerk - Virginia Drew Clerk - Dorothy Ryan Clerk - Dorothy Taylor
Ward Three	- Judge - Beatrice Crutcher Judge - LeVelle Soule Clerk - Martha Brown Clerk - Bernice Wood Clerk - Edna Calster


Section 5. That the polling places for said election shall be open from the hours of 8:00 o'clock A. M. to 8:00 o'clock P. M., on said day; that the Chief of Police is instructed to take to the polling places booths, pens, pencils and ballots for the purpose of providing for said election; and that the Recorder is directed to provide poll books therefor.

Section 6. That inasmuch as there is an immediate necessity for the funds which will be provided from the sale of the bonds herein mentioned, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
