BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of Section 8 of Ordinance No. 1288 (Compiled as 5-10.4) is amended to read as follows:

"Section 8. (1) No person shall resist a police officer or person duly empowered with police authority while acting in the performance of his duties; nor shall a person, upon request, refuse to assist, nor hinder, delay or obstruct a police officer or person duly empowered with police authority while acting in the performance of his duties."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
