ORDINANCE NO. 1414

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Contract with Morse Brothers, Inc. for street improvements, to-wit: the paving of Rose Street from Tenth Street to Eleventh Street; Ninth Street from Isabella Street to Carolina Street; Kearn Street (one block); and Harrison Street from Second Street to Fourth Street, and to obligate the City of Lebanon for the payment of \$22,683.80 for said street improvements, and that the Contract shall refer to the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Common Council, and shall be in the following form, to-wit: *See contract documents*

Section 2. That inasmuch as this Contract is for the improvement of the city streets, it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon that said work be done immediately; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
