A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING) ORDINANCE NO. 927 RELATING TO ) LICENSE FEES, AND DECLARING AN ) EMERGENCY. ORDINANCE BILL NO. <u>30</u> for 1971 ORDINANCE NO. <u>1423</u>

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 927 (Compiled as 8-6.6) is amended by the addition of a subparagraph (b) which shall read as follows:

"(b) The period of the license shall commence on January 1 and expire on December 31 of each year, and the fee shall be for the calendar year or any part thereof."

<u>Section 2.</u> Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
