ORDINANCE NO. 1426

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held as provided in Ordinance No. 1422, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 222.120; and

WHEREAS, as provided in ORS 222.170, at least two-thirds of the landowners of the property described below, who also own at least two-thirds of the land in said territory, which represents at least two-thirds of the assessed value of all real property in said territory, have, prior to the public hearing, consented in writing to the annexation and have filed a statement of their consent with the City Council; and

WHEREAS, said real property is contiguous territory to the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Lebanon, Oregon, to-wit:

Beginning on the North boundary line of the South half of the DLC of Russell T. Hill and wife, Not. No. 2342 and Claim No. 77, in Township 12 S.R.2W of the Willamette Meridian, Linn County, Oregon, at a stone marked C.S. in the center of the County Road being the continuation of Second Street in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; and running thence East 644.8 feet to the center of the County Road being the continuation of Main Street in the City of Lebanon, Oregon; thence South along the center of said County Road 190.3 feet; thence West 455.8 feet to the center line of the County Road, being a continuation of Second Street in the City of Lebanon; thence in the Northwesterly direction along the center of said County Road 266.68 feet to the place of beginning.

Subject to the rights of the public in and to that portion of the above property lying within the limits of public roads and highways.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Recorder is hereby directed to make and submit to the Secretary of the State of Oregon a copy of this Ordinance, together with a copy of the statement of consent of the landowners in said territory, and also a copy of Ordinance No. <u>1422</u> declaring that no election shall be required within the City of Lebanon.

<u>Section 3</u>. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
